



**The Lieutenant Governor's Challenge**  
**Be part of the Annual Around the Island Walk**  
**Saturday 19 June 2010**



▶ **What is it ?**

Fancy being part of the Annual Around the Island Walk but don't want to walk all 48 miles in one go? Then read on.

Itex and Rotary de la Manche were delighted to announce a new dimension to the Around the Island Walk in 2007 which gave walkers an opportunity to join His Excellency, the Lieutenant Governor of Jersey, Lieutenant General Andrew Ridgway on a personal challenge to walk around the Island in consecutive stages over four years. Each stage of the Lieutenant Governor's Challenge is walked in parallel with those walkers attempting the full distance in one go. The first stage in 2007 started at 0300 from the Elizabeth Ferry Terminal and stopped at the breakfast checkpoint at St Catherine's, a total of 10.9 miles with the second stage in 2008 starting at St Catherine's at 0600 and finishing at Haute Tombette a total of 12.8 miles. The third stage in 2009 started at Devils Hole at 12 noon and finished at Le Braye at 1830 a total of 11.1 miles. This year the fourth and final stage will commence at Le Braye at 1400 hours and complete the cumulative 48.1 miles at the main finish-line on the Waterfront.


This is your chance to become part of one Jersey's great fun days without having to commit to the whole 48 miles in one go. Come and join His Excellency, the Lieutenant Governor and you will be able to say 'I walked Around the Island of Jersey'.

▶ **When is it ?**

Starts at 1400 hours on Saturday 19 June from Le Braye. This date has been chosen as it is the Saturday most closest to Midsummer's Day which has the maximum number of daylight hours.

▶ **Fund Raising**

As in past years, every penny you raise will be donated to local charities. These are just three of the charities we are supporting this year.
